

Rules for Bridgewater State Shootout

- 2 – 15 minute (stopped time) halves
- 3 Time outs per game (to be used at anytime) One minute each.
- 5 minute half time
- Shoot 1 and 1's on the 10th FOUL.
- 7th and 8th grade levels can press, however if you are 15 points up, please take it off.
- 6th grade level can ONLY press in the last two minutes of the game IF the score is within 10 points.
- 5th grade level, please talk with opposing coaches before game, some leagues do not allow pressing or zone defense.
- Man to man defense, unless coaches talk about playing zone before their game.
- Board Certified Official on each court of the four game courts.
- BSC Staff provides Timekeepers and Score charters on each court.
- Team listed first on Schedule will be Home Team*.
- In event of Overtime, 2 minutes on clock-stopped time (jump ball)
- In event of 2nd Overtime, 1 minute on clock-stopped time (jump ball)
- If 3rd Overtime occurs then it will be “Sudden Death” 1st basket/FT scored.

* Home team will provide a scorekeeper to keep the book during the game.

Admission Passes will be available to purchase. These passes will be good for the entire weekend. Players and Coaches do not have to pay. **Please let parents know about the admission cost.**

Directions to Bridgewater State College

BSC is located off of Route 24 from either Route's 495 or 128/93

TINSLEY CENTER (TC) - Courts 1, 2, and 3:

Traveling from North or South on Route 24, you will take Exit 15 (route 104-east). Follow 104 for about 4-6 miles. At stop sign, take a left and continue on route 104. You will come to a rotary, merge onto it and about ½ around (stay in the right lanes), bear off right staying on route 104. Go through 2 sets of lights, after the 2nd light, about ½ mile down on your right will be Tinsley Drive. Take that and park in the lot to the left and you will see the new Tinsley Center out in the back. You MUST park in the Swenson Parking Lot and walk to the building. (You may have the players dropped off at the door and then park your cars in the lot.)
